BCAM Scientific Committee Meeting on December 12

The Scientific Committee met in Bilbao with the aim of evaluating the scientific proposal of BCAM over the three years since its launch in September 2008 as a BERC (Basque Excellence Research Center) and provides their insight into future development.

BCAM receives advice from the world elite in mathematics represented in its Scientific Committee. The Committee is composed of six internationally renowned researchers, authentic standards in their fields and experienced in driving ambitious and innovative international initiatives.

The chairman is the Madrid-born **Juan José MANFREDI**, the vice provost of undergraduate studies at the University of Pittsburgh, USA. The Committee also relies on the following professors: **Sir John BALL** of the University of Oxford, a former chairman of the International Mathematical Union; **Pierre-Louis LIONS** of Collège de France in Paris, the Fields Medal holder; **Sem BORST** of the Bell Laboratories in the USA; **Jean Michel CORON** of the Pierre et Marie Curie University in Paris; and **Leszek F. DEMOWICZ** of the University of Texas.



The committee meets in Bilbao every year. The next meeting will be in 2012 at the new headquarters of BCAM (Mazarredo 14, Bilbao).
