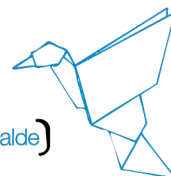

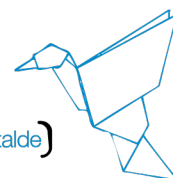

Additional documents could be requested during the evaluation process so as to check this fulfilment.</p>
Application:	<p>Required documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ CV (including the list of publications) ▪ A letter of interest ▪ 2 recommendation letters ▪ A statement of motivation describing briefly the past and ongoing research, proposed research plans, and the potential of interaction with our group (up to 4 pages + references).
Evaluation:	<p>Based on the provided application documents of each candidate, the evaluation committee will evaluate qualitatively: the adaption of the previous training and career to the profile offered, the recommendation letters, the main results achieved (papers, proceedings, etc.), the statement of past and proposed future research and other merits; taking in account the alignment of these items to the topic offered.</p>
